
The **objective** of the internal security is to make Finland the **safest country** in Europe, one of which people feel that they live in a **fair and equal society** regardless how they indentify themselves.




# The purpose of the Internal Security Programme

  - What is the situation in terms of everyday safety –
     analysing and evaluating safety in Finland
  - What needs to be improved so that we'll have a safer tomorrow measures in the Internal Security Programme
- Addressing matters that require cooperation
  - different authorities, NGOs and the business sector
  - "more than the sum of its parts"

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#### **SECURITY**

- National security services
  - The Police
  - Rescue Services
  - Emergency care
  - Customs
  - The Border Guard
  - The Finnish Defence Forces

### SAFETY

- preventive measures and actors who do preventive work
  - families
  - communities
  - social services
  - schools
  - health services
  - NGOs
  - congregations

#### PRIVATE SECTOR

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- Uninterrupted services and goods
  - Security work and services

## Implementation

- On national level
  - ministries and their agencies
- On regional level
  - regional coordination by the regional state administrative agencies
- On local level
  - local security plans, local point of view

## Follow-up

- Annual reports by October 15th
- Drafting intriguing reports
  - situation and development of internal security possibly articles
  - a summary of the progress made
  - regional implementation of the Programme
- Ministerial working group for Internal Security approves after which the report is published.
